
The O.T. book of Nehemiah unfolds the story of a man called by God to lead God's people in rebuilding the walls around Jerusalem after the Israelites returned from 70 years of captivity. The sin of an earlier generation had brought shame, brokenness, and the discipline of God. Word came to Nehemiah that God's people were "in great trouble and disgrace. The wall of Jerusalem is broken down, and its gates have been burned with fire" (Neh. 1:3). God's people were hurting due to the consequences of sin and oppression from their enemies. Nehemiah was burdened to do something. As he fervently prayed, God put a burden on His heart to return to Jerusalem and lead God's people in rebuilding the walls to protect their families, and city and restore the Lord's testimony.

God's hand was upon Nehemiah, and all the help and the resources for building the walls were provided. God's people worked together and Neh. 6:15-17 says, "the wall was completed ... in 52 days. When all our enemies heard about this ... they realized that this work had been done with the help of our God."

As we complete another year of caring for individuals, couples and families who have been affected by the damage that comes through living in a sinful fallen world, we are thankful for each of you who have come along side us to help accomplish the work God is doing through Restoration Ministries.

Isaiah 58:11-12

Insights for Relationships

When Adam and Eve disobeyed God they immediately experienced three negative emotions that all of us experience as a result of the fall of mankind. What are these emotions that so deeply affect? What has God provided so we don't need to be controlled by these emotions?

Guilt – Adam and Eve's eyes were opened and they felt guilty. Guilt means "to be "worthy of blame". They had sinned and disobeyed God and knew it. Their eyes were opened (Gen. 3:7). True guilt is the result of what we do. We have sinned before the Lord and are "worthy of blame" belonging to us. No amount of blame shifting can remove the fact that we too are guilty in God's eyes. However, the Lord Jesus took all of our guilt to the cross and cried "It's finished" because He completely paid for our sin through His death.

Shame – Adam and Eve realized they were naked and sought to cover themselves by sewing fig leaves together (3:7b). Shame is a cousin of guilt. It often accompanies one's wrongdoing but is connected to who we are. Shame can also be the result of growing up in an environment of shame or of being shamed or as a result of emotional, verbal, physical, spiritual or sexual abuse--toxic undeserved shame is dumped on a person by someone else. The Lord Jesus also took all our shame to the cross (Heb. 12:2b) and we are given a new identity as believers in Christ (2 Cor. 5:17).

Fear – Adam and Eve hid out of fear (3:10). There are many fears we struggle with (failure, rejection, abandonment, loss, being controlled, embarrassed, discovery, ect.) along with guilt and shame that can adversely affect relationships and our responses in life. These emotions are often at the root of perfectionism, being controlling, or being driven. The Lord has provided His presence, peace, power, and promises to help us over come our fears.

As you celebrate the Lord's coming this year, I want to encourage you to rest in the Lord and what He has done for you to meet these spiritual and emotional needs in your life. Allow Him to have access to whatever is causing these emotions and bring emotional healing to your heart.

Report From The Philippines:

During our training seminars in the Philippines in 2008 we partnered with Ed & Norma Gaston. They are a Christian Filipino couple who train Christians to minister to the broken hearted & help them experience the power of Jesus Christ. They are also Biblical counselors. Since Restoration Ministries plays a small part in their ministry through prayer or occasional love gifts we want to include updates about their work. If you desire to send a tax-deductible gift to the Gaston's you may do so by designating for "Philippine Ministry". Here is a brief update from Ed and Norma:

"It is with much gratitude to God & each one of you who prayed & supported us that we look back at 2013! Indeed we could not have done anything without our faithful God & your backing us up.

COUNSELING MINISTRY-216 sessions were conducted in the center for individuals & couples needing help. Several debriefing sessions were held for victims of critical incidents in Mindanao.

SEMINARS-12 counseling, marriage & parenting seminars; 4 discipleship trainings; & 5 diversified farming seminars were conducted.

COUNSELING MENTORING CLASSES-Classes continue with 10 faithful students from 4 different churches in Davao City.

TYPHOON PABLO RELIEF & REHAB PROGRAM-The rehabilitation phase is well underway. The demo farm for diversified farming has successfully yielded the people's first harvest.

100 coconuts, 600 calamansi, guapples, mongoes and squash were planted. A second demo farm is being started. The school now has a 2000 liter water tank donated by a church. Ed preached the Gospel after a farming seminar; around 50 farmers prayed to receive Christ.

TRANSLATION PROJECT-We are now translating a 6-book series for discipleship.
