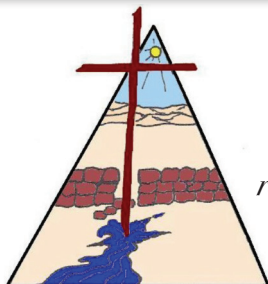

Insights for Relationships by Pastor Roger Daum

A great need in our churches is for Christian couples, who have a healthy marriage, to come alongside of other couples to mentor them. A "mentor" is a "wise trusted teacher or guide". This simple definition also describes a life coach or a discipler of others. Sometimes we as believers think that since we haven't completely worked through all our own personal problems in living we aren't qualified to help others. The good news is that having a problem and working on it is the first quality God is looking for in a Biblical mentor. We see this illustrated in the lives of men and women of faith in the Bible. They were in a process of growing and God used them and worked through them in spite of their struggles.

Moses struggled with inner feelings of inferiority and was painfully aware of his inadequacy, lack of authority, and leadership skills (Ex. 3-4). He also struggled with a problem with anger most of his life. God used Gideon to deliver Israel from Midianite oppression in spite of his fear and questioning of God (Judges 6). Jeremiah made excuses about being a prophet because he did not know how to speak and felt he was too young, inadequate, and inexperienced (Jer. 1:6). He was so depressed at one point he wished he had never been born (Jer. 20:14-18). Queen Esther was afraid to go to the King because she was fearful of death (Esther 4:11-14). Paul ministered to others publicly while struggling privately (Rom. 7:15-25).

Biblical mentors are believers in Christ who have problems but are working through them biblically to maturity and Christ likeness. They are learning how to apply God's truths in their own lives, marriages, families and are willing to lovingly come alongside of another person or couple or a small group of couples to help them learn to love and live in Christ.

3. Ed and Norma Gaston are co-workers in the Philippines. God is opening many doors for them to train Biblical counselors and do marriage enrichment seminars in Asia. They would like to come take 2 weeks of additional training with us next May. Pray God provides to make that possible.

5. Pray for those who are scheduled to come for counseling in 2015. Pray God prepares their hearts, and for wisdom and insight needed to minister to each person.

Report From The Philippines:

In addition to what God is doing here through your involvement with Restoration Ministries, we also want to share how your partnership is also being used of God as we come along side Ed and Norma Gaston from the Philippines. We met and began working with them after our training trip to the Philippines with Dr. and Mrs. Lynch in 2008. We include updates from them to encourage you to realize you are having a part in equipping the Body of Christ in Asia to do pastoral counseling. Here are some **highlights from their 2014 report:**

102 – The number of pastors and wives trained as Biblical counselors in the Philippines, India, and a country closed to the gospel.

59 individuals received counseling for personal and marriage needs.

430 believers attending counseling or marriage mentoring seminars to learn to help others apply God’s Word to relationships.

82 couples attended marriage enrichment seminars. Some of these were in areas or countries closed to the gospel.

285 families heard the Gospel through evangelistic messages by Ed as relief supplies were given to Typhoon victims. Many prayed to receive the Lord Jesus as their Savior.

Parenting seminars for **288 parents**.

Norma training **59 women** participants from 17 3rd world countries at the Haggai Institute.

Pray for them as they continue a similar schedule. Norma will be teaching in Hawaii in April of 2015 with the Haggai Institute. She and Ed would like to travel on to Nebraska in May to take 2 weeks of training as I work with couples in our office. This would be a substantial savings in air fares since her fare would already be covered from the Philippines to Hawaii.
