Insights for Relationships by Pastor Roger Daum

A great need in our culture is for Christian couples with healthy marriages to come along side other couples to mentor them. A "mentor" is a "wise trusted teacher or guide". They are a life coach or discipler of others. We've already considered that having a problem and working on it is the first quality God looks for in a Biblical mentor.


The second characteristic of a Biblical mentor is that of being a learner. You may think you can't mentor other couples because you haven't had any formal training or a degree. There is certainly a place for those who seek a degree in marriage or family relationships. However, should you disqualify yourself if you haven't had some type of formal training? What about the apostles? Did they have degrees? In Acts 4:13, it was said of them "that they were uneducated and untrained men" however people "began to recognize them as having been acquainted with Jesus." They experienced the person and power of the living Christ and shared that with others.

Has the Lord been growing you in your marriage relationship? Have you been learning how to love and value one another and develop a strong healthy Christ centered marriage? If so, we want to encourage you to come along side another couple who needs encouragement, prayer, friendship, and the wisdom that God has taught you as a learner.

Effective mentors dig deeply into their past experience for a wealth of insights and lessons God taught them through their past trials, hurts, failures, abuse, abandonment or losses. What God has done and is doing in your life and journey provides you a platform from which to share and mentor other couples. (2 Cor. 1:3-4)

Report From The Philippines:

We are thankful to partner with the Gastons. In recent months they ministered to Christians in a closed country where they taught pastors and their wives from 18 different tribal groups on acceptance, respect, communication, and forgiveness. In another location Norma taught women, who are experiencing suffering and persecution, about the worth of women to be empowered by God for ministry. Many women lined up for individual counseling.

In a recent trip to India they conducted trainings for Christian leaders and their wives. They reported, "Because of culture, the first day was a bit difficult because the couples would not even hold hands. As we proceeded with the sessions on intimacy, they slowly responded positively and actively participated in the discussions. The culminating event was the renewing of vows. However, for most of the couples it was their wedding day. The culture allowed eloping and some of them never had the blessing of being married by a pastor. Many younger couples were grateful they learned how to relate and communicate with each other. In a culture where women are not given much respect and attention, the wives were the most happy. After the couples left (now holding hands as they walked away), another group of 36 pastors and church leaders came to attend the Counseling Skills Seminars and the Conflict Management Seminar. Many of them heard of the Biblical counseling ministry for the first time and were so glad to learn practical skills. The Conflict Management was welcomed learning as they are experiencing a lot of issues in the churches."

Our Restoration Ministries board has approved paying for travel expenses to bring Ed and Norma to Cozad for further training with Roger May 2-16. Anyone desiring to give a gift to help cover these expenses can do so by designating it for "Gaston Training". We believe this is a great investment in a quality couple to facilitate Biblical pastoral counseling in Asia. God is opening amazing doors for them and given them favor with the Filipino government.
